

2012 Federal Criminal Code

The *Veterans Affairs Police Guide to the Federal Criminal Code* is a pocket-sized quick reference which unifies into one book all the Federal laws relevant to the Veterans Affairs Police. This book will enable every Police Officer, Special Agent, Criminal Investigator, and Inspector to carry a legal reference in a pocket, briefcase, glove box, or citation holder for use in the field. The binding and sturdy cover will make this a useful and tough companion.
